

# Five Little Mice

## Finger Play

Verse One: Left hand is opened, palm up, waist high, as right hand fingers move about on the palm. Then left hand moves up, head high, and fingers continue to move about on the palm.

Verse Two: Thumbs and pointer fingers form two circles placed around the eyes. Head moves back and forth looking for "mice." Next, hands jump forward as paws. Fingers of both hands then run to hide behind the back.
